

# SCULPTURES INSPIRED BY THE LIBERATION WAR

To celebrate 50 Years of independence of Bangladesh here are some well known sculptures created in honour of our cosmic achievement!

## The Aparajeyo Bangla

Syed Abdullah Khalid - the hands behind this masterpiece. This sculpture located on Dhaka University's campus has been an iconic figure since the late 70s, when it was completed. It projects the Bengali nationalist feeling- their yearning for freedom, vigilancy and strength

## Jagroto Chowrangi

The first sculpture created after the liberation of Bangladesh and built by Abrar Razaque, it is deemed as one of the greatest sculptures in Bangladesh by art critics. It is located in Jaidebpur and was constructed in 1973.

## Shabash Bangladesh

Loosely translating to 'Bravo Bangladesh', this sculpture is located at Rajshahi University. It was made to pay tribute to the sacred lives lost during the liberation war. It was also inspired by a poem named 'Durmor' written by Sukanta Bhattacharya. The last few lines of the poem has been denoted under the statue
